## **Disposal Instructions**

Portagas provides an easy and convenient way to return empty cylinders at no cost.

- Ensure that the cylinder is empty by screwing a regulator onto it and verifying that the gauge reads zero. If not, release the gas in a well –ventilated area and remove the regulator.
- Strip the outer layer of shrink wrap off of the cylinder using the pull-tab. This will reveal the prepaid shipping return label.
- Place the cylinder in the supplied tube, seal it with the rubber cap, and give the package to the listed shipper for its return.\*

CalGaz provides disposable cylinders that are 100% recyclable.

- Ensure that the cylinder is empty by screwing a regulator onto it and verifying that the gauge reads zero. If not, release the gas in a well –ventilated area and remove the regulator.
- De-core the cylinder valve with a cylinder recycling tool prior to disposal to validate that the cylinder is unpressurized:

17113275 Cylinder Recycling Tool (34L, 58L, 116L aluminum and 103L Steel)

17113283 Cylinder Recycling Tool (34L Steel only)

• Dispose of the unpressurized cylinder per local environmental laws or company policies.

CalGaz provides an easy and convenient way to return empty 650L cylinders at no cost.

- Ensure that the cylinder is empty by slowing opening the cylinder valve until cylinder is empty.
- CalGaz 650L cylinders are shipped with a cylinder return kit. If unable to locate, contact ISC for part number 18109131 nocharge return kit.
- Place the cylinder in the box provided and apply the pre-paid shipping label to the box.
- Give the package to the listed shipper for its return.

<sup>\*</sup>Tube is highly recommended but not mandatory for cylinder return.
